

BE A LEADER

The scriptures are outlined for chapters to be read morning, noon and at night. They also include one Godly deed to be done every day. It is only time consuming IF you miss a reading period... Hope you join me.

Day 1 Sit down to dinner with your family or friends. It doesn't have to be fancy; just enjoy a meal together after praising God for giving you food to eat and people to share it with. **Genesis 1-5; Job 1-6; Matthew 1-3.**

Day 2 Listen to 10 minutes of your favorite worship music. Let it encourage you and lift your spirit. **Genesis 6-10; Job 7-12; Matthew 4-6.**

Day 3 Sit down today and create a budget that will help you practice Biblical stewardship. **Genesis 11-15; Job 13-18; Matthew 7-9.**

Day 4 Today claim the promise of God that says we can do all things through Christ who strengthens us. Speak it out loud and demonstrate this in all your decisions today. **Genesis 16-20; Job 19-24; Matthew 10-12.**

Day 5 After bringing your tithes and offerings, pay yourself by putting a little money into your savings. **Genesis 21-25; Job 25-30; Matthew 13-15.**

Day 6 Pray for your children or grandchildren today, asking for God's protection, favor, and blessing on their lives. **Genesis 26-30; Job 31-36; Matthew 16-18.**

Day 7 Get God involved in your battles by engaging in thanksgiving. Give God thanks for everything He has done and for who He is – release His grace! **Genesis 31-35; Job 37-42; Matthew 19-21.**

Day 8 Honor your spouse or loved one today by speaking words of praise to them. **Genesis 36-40; Psalms 1-6; Matthew 22-24.**

Day 9 Show honor to those who are in authority over you by serving them with joy and gladness. God sees your positive attitude. **Genesis 41-45; Psalms 7-12; Matthew 25-26.**

Day 10 Spend some quality time with a child under your influence. Be Jesus to them in what you do and say. **Genesis 46-50; Psalms 13-18; Matthew 27-28.**

Day 11 Have confidence in God today; cast your cares upon Him and trust what His Word says about your future. **Exodus 1-5; Psalms 19-24; Mark 1-3.**

Day 12 Find a place in your local church to serve God. Your church needs you. **Exodus 6-10; Psalms 25-30; Mark 4-6.**

Day 13 Position yourself for success today. Ignore the praise of men and allow God to bring your purpose into focus. **Exodus 11-15; Psalms 31-36; Mark 7-9.**

Day 14 Identify a habit that is keeping you from fully experiencing abundant life, and submit that habit to Jesus. In Him you have victory over sin. **Exodus 16-20; Psalms 37-42; Mark 10-12.**

Day 15 Take authority over fear as a Believer. Give the devil something to worry about and declare that his fear tactics are no longer effective in your life! **Exodus 21-25; Psalms 43-48; Mark 13-14.**

Day 16 Invite the Holy Spirit to reign over your place of work. Now believe He will. **Exodus 26-30; Psalms 49-54; Mark 15-16.**

Day 17 You are a mountain mover! Pray for the impossible and stand in faith. **Exodus 31-35; Psalms 55-60; Luke 1-3.**

Day 18 Review a favorite passage in God's word; memorize it knowing that God will use it for someone you meet today. **Exodus 36-40; Psalms 61-66; Luke 4-6.**

Day 19 Write in the margins of your Bible one of the dreams God has put in your heart. Pray and submit the dream to the Lord daily. Remain faithful by speaking the Word of God to Him and over your dream, and He will bring you dream to pass! **Leviticus 1-5; Psalms 67-72; Luke 7-9.**

Day 20 Praise God for His bountiful provision; remind yourself that He is the only One who can meet all your needs according to His riches and glory in Christ Jesus. **Leviticus 6-10; Psalms 73-78; Luke 10-12.**

Day 21 Think of something you want to accomplish. Now create three goals that will get you to your ultimate destination. Ask God to give you focus and discipline to achieve your goal. **Leviticus 11-15; Psalms 79-84; Luke 13-15.**

Day 22 Take 5 minutes to speak blessings and affirmations to a family member. **Leviticus 16-19; Psalms 85-90; Luke 16-18.**

Day 23 This morning, as you seek God's voice, openly ask for His favor in everything you put your hands to. **Leviticus 20-23; Psalms 91-96; Luke 19-21.**

Day 24 Use Scriptures in your everyday speech today; you will notice your faith building as you plant seeds in the spiritual realm. **Leviticus 24-27; Psalms 97-102; Luke 22-24.**

Day 25 Use your influence to tell a young person about faithfulness and what it means to follow God. Invite two people to visit your church this Sunday. **Numbers 1-5; Psalms 103-108; John 1-3.**

Day 26 Sow a seed for your financial future by making a wise investment in God's Kingdom (God's way of doing things) today. **Numbers 6-10; Psalms 109-114; John 4-6.**

Day 27 Meet with a friend and ask them to identify the strengths of your character that you may not be aware of. Make a decision and develop those strengths. **Numbers 11-15; Psalms 115-120; John 7-9.**

Day 28 Refuse to entertain unbelief, standing firm on the promises from God's Word and rejecting any thought, suggestion, or inclination that goes against them! **Numbers 16-19; Psalms 121-126; John 10-12.**

Day 29 Pray in agreement with God about your finances; ask Him to bring order and peace. **Numbers 20-23; Psalms 127-132; John 13-15.**

Day 30 Every person God puts in your life is for a purpose. Learn from the people God has entrusted to you and see them through His eyes. **Numbers 24-27; Psalms 133-138; John 16-18.**
